## How to get into the system

There are two ways for running the system, either from the DOS prompt or from within Windows.

If you are in DOS, go to the directory containing the system and type "c:\<the directory>\project.exe". The system will get you into windows automatically. If you don't have Windows 3.0 or newer installed, then the most possible is that the system will not run.

If you are in windows environment, choose from the "File" submenu of the Program Manager, the option "Run" and enter the path there as you would if you were working in DOS (i.e. "c:\<the directory>\project.exe" ). If you don't know exactly the directory, select Browse option to look for it and select it.
