1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 How to use this manual

This manual has been developed, in order to help the users to understand the new system. In this manual, a fully description of the new system is being carried out, stating how each module is being performed, the logical sequence of the program modules, the different validations that exist in the program and explain them and any error that would be presented during the system execution

1.2 Environment where the system can work efficiently

The Authorized Doctors, Dentists and Clinical Laboratories system has been implemented in Microsoft Access97. For this reason Ms Office97 and Windows 95 or higher version of windows will be applicable for the program's execution. Because of the fact that Access97 has no executable facilities WinZip is also required. The system will setup through the WinZip 6.2 32-bit.

The appropriate hardware that will be needed, in order for the system to work efficiently is the following:

- Pentium running at 133mhz with 1.2gbyte hard disk, 16mbytes RAM Memory and with a floppy drive
- SVGA monitor
- Mouse
- Laser or Ink-Jet printer
