

### INTRODUCTION

### 1.1. How to use this manual.

This manual was designed as a guide to all users of the system, on how to operate the system. It explains step by step all the details of the system as simple and understandable as possible.

All user interfaces are analyzed with the help of pictures and simple narratives. It also explains what data type should be entered in each field, in every task input of data is required.

#### 1.2. Important Hints.

Before you start operating the system there are some important hints you should know related with the system.

- All forms are separated into frames, as the quantity of information was large enough to fit in one screen.
- Many of the input values can be selected from drop down menus, making the user's work much faster.
  - All the forms include the following buttons.

ADD Used to add a new record.

MODIFY Used to modify the current record.

<u>DELETE</u> Used to delete the current record.

SAVE

Used to save the changes made to the current record or to save the new record.
