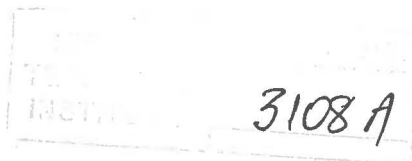

1.1. Introduction

Welcome to the Multimedia Guide for Athos Mountain. This system has been developed for the fulfillment of the requirements to get the Diploma of the Higher Technical Institute during the year 2000.

“Multimedia Guide about Athos Mountain” is a multimedia and database package that presents and explains Athos Mountain. It includes the history of Mount Athos, describes the twenty monasteries and other important places, provides information for some well known monks and the monastic life of the monks as well as it includes a photo gallery with pictures of Mount Athos. It offers a combination of videos, images, sound (speech and music) and text and makes it easier to be understood, more interesting and more user-friendly. The Multimedia Guide has a bilingual aspect (Greek and English) and it can be used for self study or for research or for live presentation purposes.

For the development of this multimedia package we have used partly coding that we have found in the On Line help, the TB II Learning Center and the Script Library Example that are provided from the Asymetrix Toolbook 5.0.
