### 1. INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Introducing the system

The purpose of this system is to create a computerized information system for clubs or societies in a tertiary educational establishment. The existing system of the most clubs the investigation has been carried out, is mostly manual except the Survivor club of the University, which uses a mixture of computerized and manual handling of information. The existing system was found very inefficient and time consuming. For this reason, a computerized system is developed to handle all this time consuming and make the overall operations of a club or society more efficient.

The new System is powerful, user-friendly, less time consuming and more efficient. It runs under Windows 98 environment. It covers all the needs of a club or society in terms of forms, reports, statistics and graphs. It maintains data about the clubs, societies, their members, councils and the activities of those clubs and societies. The system also provides basic accounting facilities and scheduling facilities for the activities of the clubs and societies as well as a calendar of events.

The system is user-friendly and includes security measures in different user levels, backup and recovery procedures, on line-help as well as a conversion to ASCII.
